CPO Engages in Key Discussions with Prisons Association As Union Negotiations Continues

November 25 2024 – Negotiations entered its second week, with Chief Personnel Officer, Commander Dr. Daryl Dindial, meeting with the Executives of the **Prison Officers' Association of Trinidad and Tobago** (**POATT**) at the **Alexandra Street** office of the Personnel Department today.

Commander Dindial expressed his sincere gratitude to the Association's President Mr. Gerard Gordon and his Executive for their continued collaboration and dedication. He acknowledged the Executives' essential role in fostering positive change and ensuring the well-being of their members.
