CPO Drives Public Service Transformation – Over 500 Trained in 2024

January 17, 2025 - The Personnel Department (Office of the Chief Personnel Officer) new Human Resource Management Compliance and Training Division (HRMCTD), created by Cabinet in 2024 provided training for over 500 Public Officers between the period March to December 2024.

This achievement underscores the **Department's** continued drive to support good governance and service excellence by enhancing the capability of **Public Officers** in pursuit of **Human Resource** (**HR**) excellence.

The recipients of the training were from multiple Ministries and Departments spanning from executive to operational level staff which included; Acting Permanent Secretaries, Deputy Permanent Secretaries and the Chief Administrator of the Tobago House of Assembly who are pivotal in translating policy to tangible service delivery outcomes. Technical staff from the Ministry of Public Utilities, Ministry of Labour, the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago, the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service, and the Judiciary of Trinidad and Tobago were also trained.

According the **Chief Personnel Officer**, **Commander Dr. Daryl Dindial**, "We are delighted to have initiated and exceeded our training goals for **2024**, empowering over **500 Public Officers** with knowledge on policy, procedures and processes to better equip them to administrate several key **HR** functions, not limited to **PMAS**, **Benefits**, **Compensation** and **Contract Employment** principles."

Commander Dindial's philosophy is that by investing in the development of **Public Officers**, we are contributing to the overall improvement of public service delivery and strengthening internal **HR** efficiencies.

Dindial revealed, another key initiative that will be launched shortly, it is a **PMAS** training video facilitated by the **HRMCTD**, which would provide **Public Officers** with easy access to a comprehensive understanding of the existing processes for performance evaluation. The video will be available on the **Personnel Department's YouTube Channel** as well as, internal electronic learning (e-learning) system which will be made available in the near future.

According to Dindial, the **Personnel Department** is committed to enhancing the capabilities of **Public Officers** through continued training and capacity-building opportunities. This effort aligns with the Department's goal of supporting a highly skilled and effective Public Service workforce.
